Carnivorous Plants

Carnivorous plants have special ways of getting food.

Most plants use sunlight, water, and <u>nutrients</u> from the soil to get the food they need to grow and survive. Carnivorous plants grow in places where the soil is poor in nutrients. They get the nutrients they are missing by capturing and eating small animals and insects.

There are many different types of carnivorous plants. These different plants are not all related to each other. However, they do share common features. All carnivorous plants use their leaves as traps to catch food. Sticky traps attach to insects and stop them from escaping. Snap traps close on prey. When animals fall into pitfall traps, they are unable to get out again.
